Q1. Draw an apple with a shadow effect, as per the diagram given below and make sure read the steps first and complete the diagram.

Shading guide for Beginners

What you need:
Pencils: F, HB, 4B, 9B
Drawing paper
Elastic eraser
Sharpener
An apple
A small desktop lamp
Stomp



Step 1:
Place apple on your desk and place the light as you want to draw it. Take your time and study the light and how it falls on the apple. Make a quick first sketch.



Step 2:
How many different shades do you see? A very common mistake among beginners is that they assume there is only light and dark. Shades are more different than what they eye wants to see. I displayed this with the greyscale on the side. Next step is to sketch the different colours of your shades.



Step 3:
To make the shades more realistic you need to blend them in. For smooth blending you can use your finger tips. For erasing out edges and hard lines I recommend using the stomper. Keep blending until you're satisfied.



Step 4:
Add more details, additional background and smudge out any additional hard lines. Use the elastic eraser to add light and its shapes. Smudge it in gently with the other shadows as seen in the picture below. Add more structure details if needed until the picture is done.

Activity: How to make a pen stand using waste paper:

step 1- Required materials

Ruler

Pencil

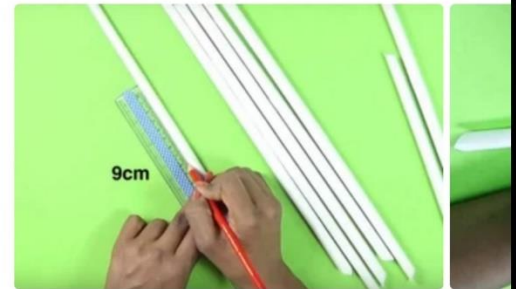
Glue Bottle

Scissors

Poster Colors with paint brush

8 Waste Paper sheets

Step 3: 9cm Mark



Now, you can mark the sheets after 9 cm three times. Now, you will have to fold the rolled papers into a triangle as you can see in the picture.

Step 2: Start Rolling Paper



In the first step, you will have to take a pencil and start rolling sheets on it. Gradually, you will have to roll all 8 waste paper sheets and you will have to close them with the help of glue.

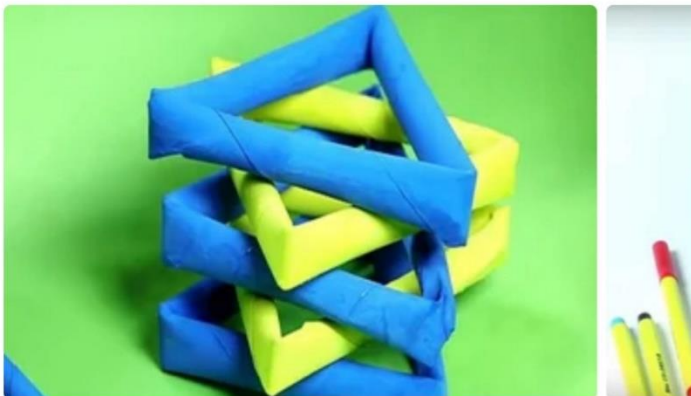


Step 4: Paint the Paper



In the third step, you will have to paint the rolled papers according to colors of your choice. I used two colors yellow and blue.

Step 5: Last Step



In the last step, just place different colors of rolled papers on each other and stuck them with the help of glue.
